DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IN SANTA ROSA COUNTY, FLORIDA SO THAT RECYCLABLE MATERIALS MAY BE RECYCLED AND PUT TO BENEFICIAL USE AS OPPOSED TO BEING WASTED BY BEING DISPOSED OF IN THE SANTA ROSA COUNTY LANDFILL. Motion carried 4-0.

Staff advised, as did Mr. Odom, that the agreement with Santa Rosa is still being reviewed by both parties. Mr. Perkins stated that he would like to see a 90-day opt-out clause contained in the agreement for either party.

ITEM 5 - OPEN FORUM

Mr. Barry Tweedie commented on the exceptional work by the Board and staff relative to the proposed agreement with Santa Rosa County for recyclables.
