Prospective Bidders:

This addendum is to notify you of questions and comments that have been received relative to this bid and the responses that have been given.

1. Can you provide a list of the non-owned disposal sites (including addresses) that the District utilizes and a list of owned vehicles (including make, model, year, VIN) that the District wants covered on the pollution liability policy?

***Response:***

In response to questions regarding our current pollution liability policy, we are providing the following.

Attached is the current policy, "Pollution Legal Liability Policy," with Arch Specialty Insurance. This policy encompasses pollution liability for fixed property locations, above ground tanks, and transportation in both owned and non-owned vehicles. We have no underground storage tanks on the policy. The above-ground tanks are included on the Arch Specialty Insurance—Underground Storage Tank Schedule, and are indicated as above ground.

Our intent, for purposes of obtaining quotes for the pollution liability policy, is for all ECUA locations to be included in the coverage. The current Fuel Tank and Chemical Tank lists have already been provided as part of the "Confidential Informational Questionnaire #2 – Pollution Liability," included in the Proposal Forms package. We are now providing the current ECUA, Florida Municipal Insurance Trust-FMIT Property Insurance Schedule and a separate ECUA Lift Station List. There will be some duplication on these lists as all fuel and chemical tanks are at locations that are also listed on the current ECUA-FMIT Property Insurance Schedule; however, not all lift stations are listed on the schedule.

- ECUA Lift Station List

**Note:** We have already provided the Chemical and Fuel Tank lists.

Additionally, the current carrier does not require a listing of vehicles for the transportation coverage provided within the policy.
