Sealed bids for Bid Number CC2015-04, CWRF Headworks Odor Control Piping, will be received in the office of the Purchasing and Stores Manager, Emerald Coast Utilities Authority, located in the Emergency Operations & Support Addition, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Ellyson Industrial Park, Pensacola, FL 32514, until 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday, December 9, 2014, at which time bids submitted will be publicly opened and read aloud in the adjacent Room 2202, Finance Conference Room. Bids received after 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday, December 9, 2014 will be returned unopened. A Pre-bid Conference will not be required; however, a pre-bid site visit shall be REQUIRED and scheduled by the bidder. Verification of the site visit shall be via submission of a Site Visit Verification Form signed by a current ECUA representative (see page 00003-15) and included in the bid proposal. Bids received from entities that did not attend the mandatory pre-bid site visit will be returned unopened. The principal features of work will consist of the fabrication and installation of odor control piping for the CWRF Headworks. Oral and other interpretations or clarifications will be without legal effect.
