This pre-bid is not mandatory, but attendance is strongly encouraged. The principal features of the work will consist of the installation of 8" diameter PVC gravity sewer, 4" precast manholes, 4" building service laterals, replacement of 2" water main with 4" water main and house service transfers, roadway and grass restoration and related work in Alexia, Griffith, Hayworth, Regiment and Atilla Avenues and Dunkirk Street.
