Sealed bids for Bid Number CC2013-10, Lift Station #12 (Eastgate) Replacement, will be received in the office of the Purchasing and Stores Manager, Emerald Coast Utilities Authority, located in the Emergency Operations & Support Addition, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Ellyson Industrial Park, Pensacola, FL 32514, until 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday, October 29, 2013, at which time bids submitted will be publicly opened and read aloud in the adjacent Room 2202, Finance Conference Room. Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened. A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held in the office of the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority Engineering Department, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Pensacola, Florida, at 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday, October 15, 2013. A non-mandatory site review will immediately follow at the existing lift station on Wood Stream Drive, Pensacola, Florida 32514. The principal features of the work will consist of demolition and replacement of the existing lift station including a new wet well, new pumps, new control panels, new generator and associated gravity and pressure piping, valves, fittings, electrical components, and site improvements including lift station demolition, backfilling, grading, grassing and fencing.
