Taking a Turn for the Better

The Emerald Coast Utilities Authority (ECUA) Board members turned a symbolic valve on Thursday, December 2, to mark the completion of our new, \$316-million Central Water Reclamation Facility (CWRf) – on time and under budget! Current and former ECUA board members and staff, as well as federal, state and local officials, were on hand as the state-of-the-art facility officially began operations.

With the CWRf complete, ECUA plans to demolish the aging Main Street facility, which many believe will help encourage economic development in the area. Another benefit is that reclaimed water from that facility will no longer be discharged into Pensacola Bay. Thanks to innovative partnerships with Gulf Power Company and International Paper, reclaimed water from the CWRf will be reused by those two companies in their industrial processes. Additionally, the facility is well above the flood plain and is built to resist hurricane-force winds. Redundant power and storage systems help to ensure that the facility can remain operational during conditions that crippled the Main Street Plant during Hurricane Ivan in 2004.

The CWRf was funded in large part through grants from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and other federal sources, the State of Florida, Escambia County and the City of Pensacola. Several local firms, employing hundreds of Northwest Florida employees, participated in the design and construction of the facility, three major lift stations and 25 miles of pipeline.

A turn for the better for our community; an achievement of which we at ECUA are truly proud!



The aim of ECUA's Residential Cooking Grease Disposal Program is to help ECUA customers capture and dispose of their cooking grease in an environmentally safe and effective way. ECUA has containers available that you can use to store and dispose of household cooking grease. You can pick up a container and return it, once filled, at any of the locations listed below, exchange it for an empty one and repeat the process. It's that simple! This time of year, when we produce more grease in holiday meal preparations and temperatures are cooling off, is the right time to make use of the grease disposal program. Help us keep sewer lines and your home's plumbing clear and unclogged.

Residential Grease Disposal Program Drop-Off / Pick-Up Sites

- ECUA at Ellyson Industrial Park: Across the street from 9255 Sturdevant St. (Outside gate left of Garage Entrance).
- ECUA Sanitation Department: 3050 Godwin Lane (East end of employee parking).
- ECUA Main Street Plant: 401 W Government St. (Corner of Government & Coyle Sts.).
- ECUA Bayou Marcus Water Reclamation Facility: 3050 Fayal Dr. (Outside gate right of plant entrance).
- Clean & Green: 3303 N. Davis Hwy. (Left of company sign).
- Via de Luna Drive on Pensacola Beach, between the Pensacola Beach Elementary School and Our Lady of Assumption Catholic Church.
- Aboard NAS Pensacola (for base personnel only), stations are located at:
 - Andrew Jackson Court
 - Fort Santa Maria de Galve Hase Road and Slemmer Avenue
 - Abb Street across from the Naval Survival Training Institute
