



Requirements for Approved Haulers

- Maintaining Grease Interceptor
- Disposing of FOG Properly
- Submitting Customer Reports
- Committed to Serving Customers and Supporting the ECUA FOG Program

Duties of Approved Haulers:

1. Inspections of Grease Interceptors
2. Pumping Grease Interceptions-As Needed and/or Required
3. Any Report or “Pump-Out” Deficiencies Will Be Communicated to the Hauler
4. “Pump-Out” Reports Mailed to ECUA’s Environmental Control Program, Within 10 Days of any “Pump-Out”

Responsibilities of Approved Grease Haulers

1. Any Late or Incomplete “Pump-Out” Report is the Responsibility of the Hauler
2. All Grease Interceptor Issues Will Be Discussed with the Hauler
3. Required to Submit Reports to ECUA

Non- Approved Haulers

1. All Issues Will Be Discussed with the ECUA Customer
2. Focus Will Be On The ECUA Customer
3. May Complete and Submit Reports to Customer, But Submittal of the Report is Not the Responsibility of a Non-Preferred Hauler
