

What Can I Place in My Recycling Can?

Yes! Please Recycle These Items:

- Glass; any color
- Junk Mail & Envelopes
- Office and School Papers (colored paper)
- Boxboard (cereal, cake & cracker boxes, etc.)
- Plastic Produce Clamshells
- Plastic Milk Jugs; 2-Liters; bottles and containers
- Plastic Cups, Plates, Utensil
- Pet Food Cans and Dry Pet Food Bags
- Balls of Tin Foil; Foil Pie Tins
- Metal Pots, Pans & Cookie Sheets
- Egg Cartons, cardboard only at this time
- Electronics: **NOTE: These recyclables should be disposed of through ECUA's Bulk Recycling Program, not in the curbside recycling container. Please call 476-0480 to schedule a pick-up, it's free!**
- Newspaper & Inserts
- Cardboard
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Phone Books
- Brown Paper Bags (grocery)
- Pizza Boxes
- Plastics No. 1 through 7
- Plastic & Metal Hangers
- Aluminum Cans & Lids
- Aluminum Foil Baking Pans
- Tin and Steel Cans & Lids
- Bubble Wrap

No! Do Not Recycle These Items:

• No Plastic Bags — **NOTE: Recyclables CAN be placed in plastic bags to avoid fly-away items.** We do encourage the use of plastic bags to hold other recyclables such as loose or shredded paper, and especially packaging “peanuts”, which are difficult to keep contained. Please tie these bags securely to prohibit them from flying out of the recycling truck. When disposing of plastic bags in your regular garbage can, please bundle them up into one bag, and secure them well to keep them from littering our streets.

Also, please check with your local grocery stores to see if they collect plastic bags for recycling.
