Packing Peanuts: **2B Postal** will be glad to accept all forms of clean and dry packing peanuts. All colors are accepted, even static free and biodegradable. If they are separated by color that is a plus, but they are happy to accept mixed bags for general shipping use.

Bubble Wrap: **2B Postal** will gladly accept used or unused bubble wrap as long as it is clean and dry and 90% bubble intact. They can accept bubble wrap in loose sheets or completed rolls, popped or torn sheets are no longer usable, and will not be accepted.

Please bring average-sized quantities to their store located at 6901-A N 9TH Avenue, Pensacola, (on the corner of 9th Ave. and Creighton Rd., in the Eastgate Plaza) during regular business hours.
