Sealed bids for Bid Number CC2011-15, Downtown South (A4)-Pen Haven Phase II (G3) CIPPL Sewer Rehabilitation will be received from prequalified bidders only by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority Purchasing And Stores Manager, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Ellyson Industrial Park, Pensacola, FL 32514, until 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday, June 28, 2011, at which time bids submitted will be publicly opened and read in Room 215, Purchasing Section, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the ECUA Customer Service Building. A Pre-bid Conference will be held in the offices of the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, 9300 Sturdevant St., Pensacola, Florida, at 1:30 p.m., local time, Thursday, June 9, 2011. The principal features of the work will consist of the installation of cleaning and inspection of 6-inch to 18-inch sewer mains; the installation of 6-inch to 18-inch cured-in-place pipe liner (CIPPL) to 6-inch to 18-inch sewer mains; reinstatement of service laterals; completion of excavated point repairs and pipe and lateral replacement; bypass pumping operations; and warranty tests and inspections in accordance with the Contract Drawings and Specifications. If documents are returned within three business days in a condition that can be reused, then a full refund will be provided. Checks shall be made payable to Malcolm Pirnie, Inc. and accompanied by a note requesting bid documents CC2011-15. A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, for Category two (\$35,000) for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list. Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of at least ninety (90) calendar days from the date of opening. Complete insurance coverage and bonds will be required from the successful bidder prior to signing the contract. The Emerald Coast Utilities Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any bid informalities, to rebid the project and to accept the proposal which in its judgment is the lowest and best bid of a responsive bidder. In accepting a bid, the ECUA may award a contract based only on the base bid, the base bid plus all

alternates or the base bid plus any alternates which ECUA selects – with all decisions being made based on what the ECUA believes to be in the best interest of ratepayers, in the reasonable exercise of its discretion. ECUA further reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities as may be required to meet the needs of ECUA, at the unit price which was bid. The ECUA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age, and handicapped status in employment or provision of service. Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened.
