Sealed bids for Bid Number CC2011-19, ECUA Perdido Key Drive Gravity Sewer will be received by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority Purchasing And Stores Manager, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Ellyson Industrial Park, Pensacola, FL 32514, until 2:00 p.m., local time, Tuesday, July 12, 2011, at which time bids submitted will be publicly opened and read in Room 215, Purchasing Section, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the ECUA Customer Service Building. A pre-bid conference will be held in the offices of the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Room 205, 9300 Sturdevant St., Pensacola, Florida, at 10:00 a.m., local time, Tuesday, June 21, 2011. The principal features of the work will consist of the construction of approximately 7,200 linear feet of gravity sewer connecting to three existing ECUA lift stations. Pump and electrical upgrade to two of the three lift stations and demolition of three existing ECUA lift stations. In accepting a bid, the ECUA may award a contract based only on the base bid, the base bid plus all alternates or the base bid plus any alternates which ECUA selects – with all decisions being made based on what the ECUA believes to be in the best interest of ratepayers, in the reasonable exercise of its discretion.
