Sealed bids for Bid Number CC2011-04, Main Street Wastewater Treatment Plant Demolition will be received by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority Purchasing And Stores Manager, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Ellyson Industrial Park, Pensacola, FL 32514, until 2:00 p.m., local time, Wednesday, February 23, 2011, at which time bids submitted will be publicly opened and read in Room 215, Purchasing Section, 2nd floor of the ECUA Customer Service Building. A Mandatory Pre-bid Conference and Site Review will be held at 9:00 a.m. local time, Thursday, February 3, 2011 in the offices of Baskerville Donovan Inc, 449 West Main Street, Pensacola, Florida, and continuing at the Main Street Wastewater Treatment Plant (MSWWTP), 401 West Government Street, Pensacola, Florida. The pre-bid conference shall include a site review of the MSWWTP. The site visit is a Mandatory component of the pre-bid conference. The principal features of the work will consist of the complete demolition of the 20MGD Capacity Main Street Wastewater Treatment Plant (MSWWTP) with limited exceptions. Demolition will generally include removal of all man-made features down to elevation 3' NGVD and filling, grading and grassing of the site. Structures to be wholly or partially removed include headworks, aerated grit chamber, flow equalization basins, primary and secondary clarifiers, OASES treatment basins, a filter complex, UV disinfection system, biosolids storage thickening, dewatering and drying facilities, solids handling building, dryer building, administration and lab building, miscellaneous electrical process and storage buildings, pumping stations, site civil work and miscellaneous structures and appurtenances. A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract

with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity, and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, Florida Statutes, for Category two (\$25,000) for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list. Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of at least ninety (90) calendar days from the date of opening. Complete insurance coverage and bonds will be required from the successful bidder prior to signing the contract. The Emerald Coast Utilities Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any bid informalities, to rebid the project and to accept the proposal which in its judgment is the lowest and best bid of a responsive bidder. In accepting a bid, the ECUA may award a contract based only on the base bid, the base bid plus all alternates or the base bid plus any alternates which ECUA selects – with all decisions being made based on what the ECUA believes to be in the best interest of ratepayers, in the reasonable exercise of its discretion. The ECUA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age, and handicapped status in employment or provision of service. Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened.
